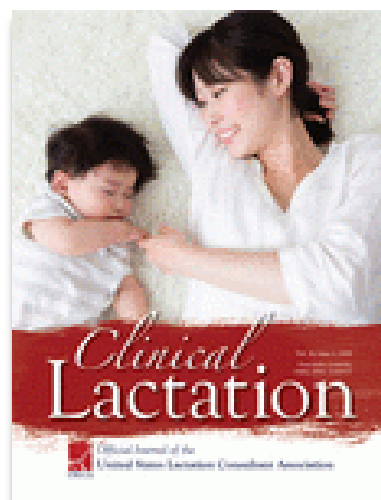

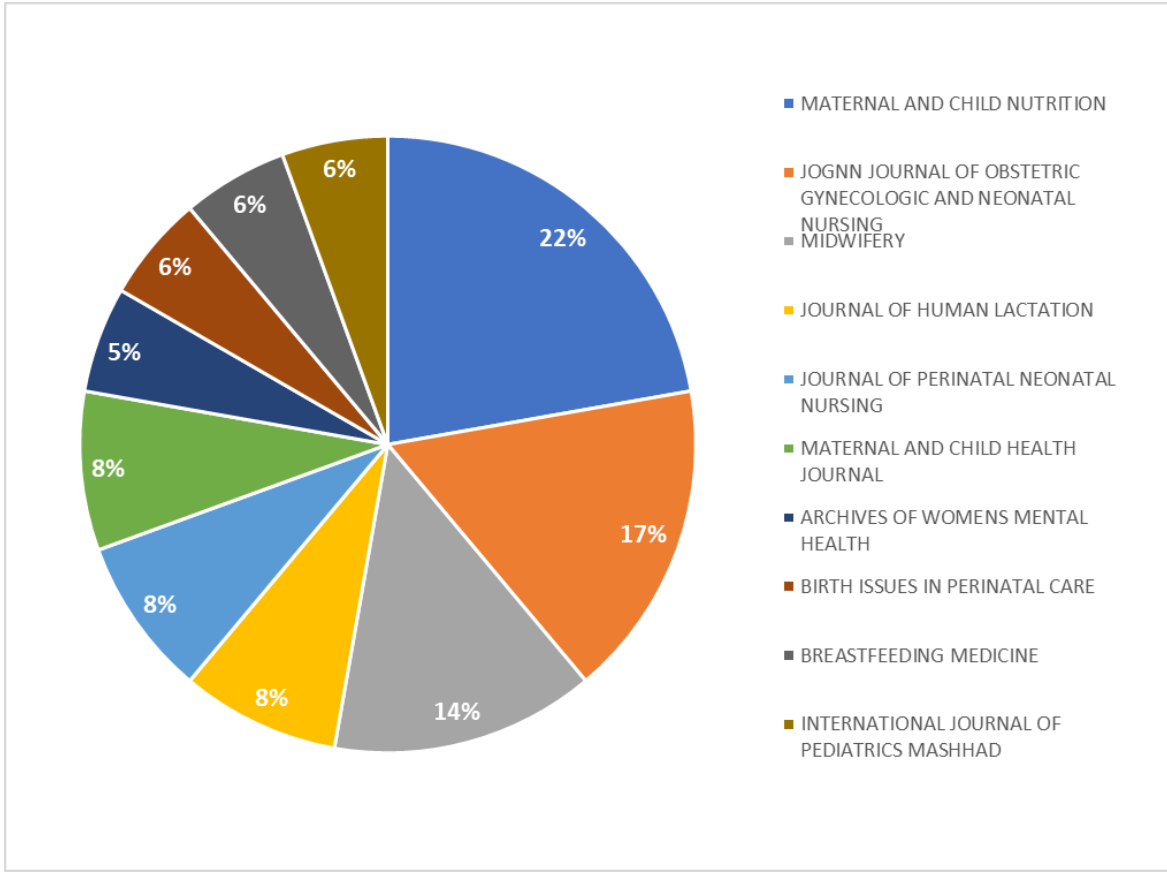

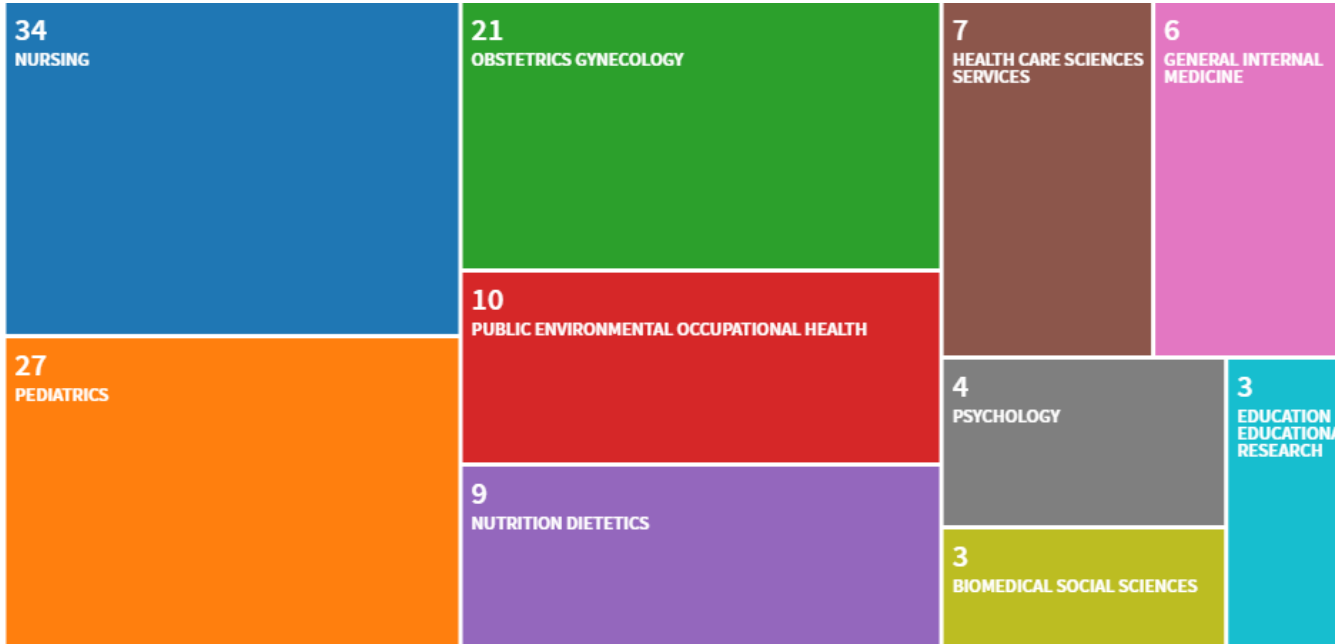


Top 10 Journals Citing Clinical Lactation
