If folks would like to send supplies, we are seeking the following:

- Plastic Totes or Bins with Lids
 - Size: At least shoebox size, slightly larger is acceptable.
 - Purpose: These totes or bins will hold all the cleaning and feeding supplies and can double as a dishpan or clean storage for families.
- Liquid Dish Soap (3 oz or smaller)
 - Current need: Urgent.
 - Larger containers can be portioned into smaller bottles if necessary. These smaller sizes are ideal for portability and safety during travel..
- Bleach (1.43 quarts/46 ounces or smaller)
 - Larger bottles cannot be safely portioned, so please stick to the recommended size.
 - 100% bleach. No scents or additives. No splash-less or "no-splash" bleach, as it does not disinfect. Just bleach in the recommended size.
 - Purpose: Bleach is essential for disinfecting feeding items and preventing the spread of harmful bacteria.
 - Important: Avoid larger sizes, as bleach cannot be divided.
- Bottle Brushes
 - Current need: Urgent.
 - These are essential for properly cleaning bottles and other feeding equipment, especially in conditions where sterilization is challenging.
- Sanitizing Bags:
 - Current need: Urgent.
 - These bags are crucial for ensuring that feeding items like bottles, cups, and pump parts are safely sanitized, especially in emergency shelters where access to clean water may be limited.
- Booties for Volunteers:
 - Booties will help protect shoes and prevent contamination during kit assembly and distribution. These are especially important for volunteers working on the ground.
